

Directions to Ashburnham Office (Aug. 2006)

1.1 From 401

1. Drive Toronto to Port Hope on 401
2. Take second Port Hope exit – marked Highway 28 North (Exit number 464). You will loop back over the 401. Turn right at the lights which will be Highway 28 North
3. Travel 19k to Bailieboro a small town on Highway 28 North
4. On the way to Bailieboro, Highway 28 North will pass Rice Lake and the signs for Bewdly. You will catch one glimpse of Rice Lake on the way down the hill (on your right). You will see the North wall of the lake and that is actually where you are headed.
5. Enter Bailieboro – you will be driving down a hill and on your right is DoDoos, a wooden sided restaurant – turn right beside DoDos onto the Lake View road. It is paved.
6. Travel for about 8 Km until you hit a 4 way stop.
7. Osprey nests are on the power poles around you at the corner and across the road you can see a very small marina.

Here you make a choice about whether to travel on gravel roads or paved roads

<i>Paved</i>	<i>Gravel</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turn left and stay on County Road #2 for 5.2 Km 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • continue on that road (dirt) and do not get off it
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The road is hilly but mainly straight for approximately 3.5 Km. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the road will be straight for about ½ mile, then go into S bend – then it will continue for about 3 miles. Do not lose faith. Shortly after leaving the S bends you will see in the far distance a very large red roof –that is the office. Just as you go into the S bends the name of the road will change to Nicholson’s Road. – Stay on it.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After about 4.2 Km the road will bend to the right and you will be going down hill. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will pass two side roads – do not lose faith –keep going
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the bottom of the hill, you will see a road on the right – East 4th Line – if you miss it you will come to the River 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will pass a red painted barn on the left – you are now 300 yards from a stop sign
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turn right onto the gravel road it will wind through a swamp and climb a hill. At the top of the hill, the farm is on the left. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the stop sign the office is dead ahead – BUT you have to turn left and travel about 50 yards to the gates. The road is called the



East 4 th Line - South Monaghan.

The farm fire number is 1150 and the gates are painted green

Timing – from the airport 2 hours almost exactly

From the 401 at highway 28 – about 30 minutes

Do not speed much on Highway 28 it is often monitored.

1.2 From Toronto Airport Via Markham and 407

For those to the west of Toronto, the 407 right on through

Directions are for airport to 407 to office.

1. Drive from the airport on Highway 409 and follow the signs to Highway 407 and then head East to Markham.
2. Stay on Highway 407 to the end. Take the option to stay of Highway 7. If you decide to go south on Brock Road, you will arrive at Highway 401. If you do, go to the above instructions and follow from 1.
3. Travel to Brooklin – do not change course – do not get off the road – go right through – do not turn for Lindsay
4. The road out of Brooklin will be ok and then will turn north –BUT with a straight ahead option – TAKE the straight ahead option. The road is smaller and dips and turns but then gets better after emerging just to the East of Oshawa north of the Taunton road. As it emerges you will be in a sharp valley with a sawmill on left and rise abruptly to a yield. The road coming in is from Taunton Road. Go STRAIGHT ahead.
5. This road will continue until it hits the 115 where there is a boat sales operation
6. Amazingly go south on 115 for ½ mile and exit on the Kirby exit and to EAST. Look on your map and you will see the village of Garden Hill – this road goes through it.
7. That road is dead straight for 90% and runs over to highway 28 where you pick up the directions just before Rice Lake. Turn left North onto Highway 28 follow the above instruction starting at Number 4.

1.3 Instructions Provided to Traveling Scots

These are directions from civilization (Oshawa, Markham, Pickering and Toronto) to the farm

Head East either via the 401 (if you prefer the 401 driving) or Taunton Road in Oshawa if you prefer a more country route - either way you are heading east and take these routes until you reach the 115 highway - head North on the 115 - take the Kirby exit and head East - you are now on the Ganaraska Forest Road, you will pass through several small villages - Elizabethville, Garden Hill etc., you will come to the first set of lights which is the Highway 28 intersection, turn left - you are now heading North on highway 28 - first village is Bailieboro, take the first right turn (Do Do's restaurant is on the corner) follow this road until you come to a STOP sign, its a four way stop, turn Left (you are now heading North) follow this road for about five minutes you will pass county road 3 and county road 4, immediately following you will see East Fourth Line on your right (at the bottom of a hill after an S bend)(if you reach Bensfort Bridge you have gone about 1 k too far), turn right onto East Fourth Line and follow the road around until you come to the first driveway on the left, the gate should be open this is the farm driveway - you can't miss it, it has the largest barns in the county with red roofs.(number 1150 with Stevenson on the mailbox.).....
